The successful applicant will be primarily responsible for developing and delivering part of the content in pharmacology in an integrated format in the first year of the curriculum and in an organ-system based curriculum in the second year.

Successful applicant will collaborate with both Basic Science and Clinical faculty to integrate and reinforce concepts throughout all four years of the curriculum. Applicants are required to have a doctoral degree in pharmacology or related field and have extensive experience in presenting content in these areas to medical students.

The College of Medicine aspires to become an extraordinary research-based Institution training physicians of the future who will become exemplary physicians, leaders in medicine, scholars in science, innovators in medical technology and compassionate providers of health care. Preliminary accreditation has been granted and UCF's College of Medicine admitted its first class of 41 students in August of 2009. As part of the "Medical City" at Lake Nona which is currently under construction, just east of the Orlando International Airport, the College of Medicine takes residence on the UCF Health Sciences Campus among the Burnham Institute for Medical Research, Nemours Children's Hospital, M.D. Anderson Cancer Research Institute and the VA Medical Center Orlando.
