The University of Central Florida, College of Medicine is seeking applications from outstanding clinician-educators in Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, Primary Care, Pediatrics, and Endocrinology at all ranks to serve as faculty on a team building this century's premier medical college. Faculty will collaborate in the development of the four year curriculum, the teaching of the practice of medicine, physical diagnosis, and organ-based systems modules, and development of innovative teaching technologies and simulations. Faculty will also be expected to spend a portion of time in our developing clinical practice or other community practice opportunities. Important concepts such as patient-centered and multidisciplinary care, preventive medicine, wellness, evidence-based medicine, palliative care, geriatrics and patient safety will be emphasized throughout the curriculum.

The College of Medicine aspires to become an extraordinary research-based institution training physicians of the future who will become exemplary physicians, leaders in medicine, scholars in science, innovators in medical technology and compassionate providers of health care. Preliminary accreditation has been granted and UCF's College of Medicine admitted its first class of 40 students in August of 2009. As part of the "Medical City" at Lake Nona which is currently under construction, just east of the Orlando International Airport, the College of Medicine takes residence on the UCF Health Sciences Campus among the Burnham Institute for Medical Research, Nemours Children's Hospital, M.D. Anderson Cancer Research Institute and the VA Medical Center Orlando.

Candidates must be board certified in an ABMS specialty; the exception is physicians who have just completed training in the last 2-5 years (length of time depends on specialty). Candidates must be eligible for licensure or licensed to practice in the State of Florida. Applicants should have significant teaching and clinical experience, and evidence of teaching excellence. Experience as a course or clerkship director, residency or fellowship program director is beneficial.
